Dear friends,

The name of Beulah was applied to the Promised Land after the people of Israel were redeemed from their captivity. Imagine how beautiful their home country looked after years

of exile! Over the years, it became a name used by faithful people to denote a beautiful place where they would dwell together. Fairfield is a name that finds its roots in the same appreciation of the gift of God's beautiful creation. (The British always understate things! The Scots of our heritage were more poetic using the term, Campbell, to express the same appreciation!) So, it seems almost providential to me that we would end up with a relationship between the Hebrew named Beulah Church and the British named Fairfield Church.

What a beautiful relationship it has become. I burst with pride when I hear from the folks of Beulah Church how warm and welcoming the Fairfield congregation has been. My heart has been warmed when I hear Fairfield people telling me what a wonderful group of people the Beulah folk are. Never being one who really believes in coincidences, I truly believe this whole experience has been a work God is doing in our midst.

Where are we right now? We are growing closer to becoming one congregation sharing two different histories and one common love of serving Jesus Christ. The plan right now is to present our case to the Presbytery of the James at their October meeting. Then working backward from that we will hold two separate but concurrent congregational meetings to approve the details of the merger. Two weeks or more before that we will have a joint "family gathering" to present the facts and to answer any questions anyone may still have.

What are we still doing? There are any number of details that we still need to be ironed out. The major one is working out a shared use agreement with a small SBC new church which would love to house their congregation in the historic Beulah Church. This may be an answer to how we use the Beulah facility to further advance the mission and ministry of Jesus Christ in Mechanicsville. Keep the Team of Seven in your prayers as they prayerfully discern God's leading in this relationship.

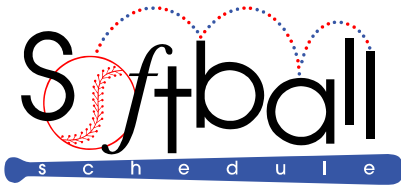

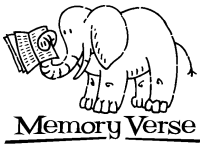
When author Gary Smalley asked 100 people to share how they knew they'd received their parents' blessing, they offered these memories of fatherly love:


Make this keepsake to express love for your dad or another special man this Father's Day.

5. Sign your names and the date at the bottom.


