Dear friends,

Session

Noted from your Session:

- A rental agreement between **Gingerbread Cottage Preschool** and Fairfield Church for the school year 2017 -2018 was authorized and subsequently signed. We will be hosting them for one year while their current hosts are rebuilding in a new location. They will pay us \$600.00 per month and other considerations for the use of several children's classrooms.
- Heard a report that the **9:00 a.m. Worship Task Force** will be soliciting input and opinions on the location of that worship service. If you have input please email Darren@fairfieldpcusa.org
- Set the annual meeting of the Congregation for December 18th in the Sanctuary at 10:05 a.m. The purpose of this meeting is for the election of officers and to approve the changes in terms of call for our Pastors.
- Set the time for **Christmas Day Worship at 11:00 a.m.** with a simple service of Lessons and Carols. New Years day will resume the regular schedule with a service of commitment renewal at both 9:00 and 11:00. Communion for January will be on Sunday January 8th rather than the 1st due to anticipated light attendance on the 1st.
- Learned that **A.P. Grappone and Sons** will be donating a stone marker to denote the 182 years of Presbyterian Christian witness at the site of the Historic Beulah Church.
- Approved the **Lease of Historic Beulah Church** to the Grace United Family Church for \$1,000. per month and other considerations. Income from this rent will be placed in the Beulah Fund for the maintenance of the Historic Beulah Church.

The Lease begins December 23, 2016 and extends until December 31, 2017 and is renewable annually.

- Approved the date of December 21, 2016 for our **Blue Christmas** worship service. This annual tradition helps those for whom the Christmas season is a difficult one because of the loss of someone they have loved or for other challenges and difficulties in their life.
- Approved the **challenge budget for 2017** at virtually the same amount as 2016 since the variables of the addition of Beulah Church members and the loss of so many wonderful members who were promoted to Glory calls for us to look cautiously forward. We nonetheless are hopeful to expand the budget after receipt of pledges to do more mission and ministry in 2017.

- Set the salary increase for Staff at 2% in keeping with the **cost of living increase**.

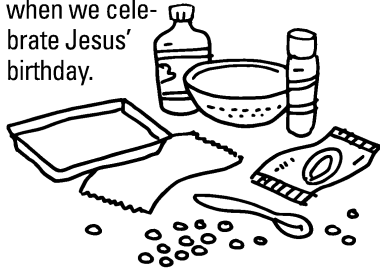
