The melody was composed by Franz Schubert and the text by his good friend, Johann Phillip Neumann. Neumann was a college professor teaching physics, but was also a poet. He felt led by God to write hymns that were assessable to the "wider congregation" and not just the well education. His lyrics were scripture focused and, as he said, "simple." He references Revelation 4:8 as the inspiration for the words.
